



2017 CAPITAL ONE ORANGE BOWL MEDIA INFORMATION

Team arrivals: Wisconsin will arrive at Miami International Airport (Signature Flight Support) on Sunday, December 24, tentatively at 4 p.m. Miami will arrive at the Diplomat Resort & Spa via Bus on December 25 at approximately 8 p.m. Please contact the Orange Bowl Communications Department for instructions, last minute changes in exact locations and times if you plan on meeting the teams. ****Credentials will not be necessary for covering arrivals; however, you must provide security information to Orange Bowl Communications office by Dec. 21 in order to receive FAA clearance for Wisconsin Arrival.**

Official Team Headquarters: Miami will be headquartered at the Diplomat Resort & Spa located on 3555 South Ocean Drive, Hollywood, FL 33019 and Wisconsin at Trump National Doral-Miami located on 4400 NW 87th Avenue, Miami, FL 33178. Nova Southeastern University (Miami) and Barry University (Wisconsin) will serve as the practice sites for the teams.

Official Media Headquarters: The Renaissance Fort Lauderdale Cruise Port Hotel located at 1617 SE 17th Street, Fort Lauderdale, FL 33316 will serve as the Official Media Headquarters for the 2017 Capital One Orange Bowl. The press headquarters room will be located in Levanto. All Miami and Wisconsin bowl materials will be available in the headquarters, as well as daily practice reports, schedule updates, notes and quotes. Hours of operation are:

- **December 26:** Noon to 6 p.m.
- **December 27 – 29:** 8 a.m. to 6 p.m.
- **December 30 – December 31:** 8 a.m. to Noon

All credentials may be picked up at the Official Media Headquarters of the 2017 Capital One Orange Bowl in Levanto from Dec. 26 – 30 or at Hard Rock Stadium Media Will Call (located at SW Gate) on Dec. 30. **NO MEDIA CREDENTIALS WILL BE MAILED.** Hours of operation are:

- **December 26:** 2 p.m. to 6 p.m. (*Credentials not needed for Miami arrivals at the Airports*)
- **December 27 – 30:** 8 a.m. to 6 p.m.
- **December 30: Hotel,** 8 a.m. – Noon...**Hard Rock Stadium,** 3 p.m. until start of second quarter (Media Will Call, SW Gate)

Media Workroom: The Media Workroom will be located in Mistral A-B on the second floor. The rooms will be equipped with desktop computers, high-speed internet connectivity and a laser printer. The rooms also contain telephones, of which all long distance phone calls must be made through calling cards/credit cards. The workroom's hours of operation are:

- **December 26:** Noon to 11 p.m.
- **December 27 – December 30:** 8 a.m. to 11 p.m.
- **December 31:** 8 a.m. to Noon

Media Hospitality: The Media Hospitality Room is located in Pampero A-B on the second floor of the Renaissance Fort Lauderdale Cruise Port Hotel. Members of the Media are encouraged to spend their downtime in the hospitality room enjoying snacks and beverages courtesy of the Orange Bowl. The hospitality room is open from 7 a.m. until 1 a.m. daily.

On the evening before the game, the 2017 Orange Bowl Media Party will be held in the Atlantic Ballroom of the Ft. Lauderdale Renaissance Cruise Port from 7:30 – 10:30 p.m. Fine dining – South Florida style – as well as drinks, music and fun will highlight the evening for all media members.

Media Shuttles: The Orange Bowl Communications Department will provide courtesy shuttles from the Renaissance Fort Lauderdale Cruise Port Hotel to Hard Rock Stadium on the day of the game. Shuttles will run at 3:15 p.m., 4 p.m., 4:30 p.m. and 5:45 p.m., and will pick up members of the media at the Renaissance Fort Lauderdale Cruise Port Hotel and drop off near Gate SE of Hard Rock Stadium. The shuttle service will start to transport members of the media back to the Renaissance Fort Lauderdale Cruise Port Hotel after the conclusion of the game. The postgame shuttles will run every 45 minutes (approx. 11:45 p.m. – 2:45 a.m.) until the last person has left the press box. Postgame pick-up will occur in the Parking Lot across from Gate SE.

Game Day Multimedia Services: Complimentary wireless, hard-wire and high-speed internet access will be available in the press box and digital photo workroom. Satellite Parking: Satellite truck parking for all TV stations will be in the parking area outside of the West Gate of Hard Rock Stadium. Enter Parking Gate 7 from 203rd Street off 27th Ave.

Live Telecasts: On game day, non-originating telecasters may originate live programming from the field until approximately 45 minutes before kickoff until after ESPN has concluded its live coverage from the site, at which time live programming may resume. Television stations or networks may use up to three minutes of footage for television news highlight purposes during the 72 hours after the game. All footage must contain the ESPN logo throughout and must be accompanied by the graphic “Courtesy ESPN.”
